

CAREER EDUCATION*

The attitude towards occupational briefing and orientation is altering because of rapidly changing society and therefore there is a necessity not to inform only but also to nurture some career planning skills, that is, to teach to receive and implement real career-related decisions, to adjust to constantly occurring changes. A successful career is the essential condition for person's social adaptation, trust in himself/herself, responsibility, the steadiness of life and the ability to plan his/her life. Career projection is perceived as a life-long process. Career planning is considered to be a life-long learning process and the services of occupational information and career counselling as the most important elements of life-long learning strategy. This course intends to prepare qualified career education specialists who would gain some theoretical and applied knowledge about career education, would be able to apply it in planning and modelling occupational career. The subjects during the course: the career counselling of school children, the theory and methodology of job search, researches on labour market, education policy and sociology, etc. Once graduated from the study programme the holders of Master's degree in Career Education will be qualified to work as career education specialists and career counsellors in all kinds institutions of formal education, at the career centres of higher education schools, at the regional labour market offices and jobcentres, information and counselling centres, youth career centres, occupational information centres as managers and counsellors. The holders are able to further study PhD.
